STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- Prepare for and attend every ground school class, two nights a week for nine weeks.
- Schedule test make-ups (if necessary) in a timely fashion.
- Study with tutor out of class if any test not passed with minimum score of 80%.
- Contact flight instructor from list and schedule flight instruction.
- Contribute \$20.00 for each and every flight lesson.
- Attend quarterly safety/informational briefing.
- Help to maintain the aircraft by attending routinely scheduled maintenance sessions and/or plane washes twice a month.
- Help with fund raising activities through direct participation and ticket sales.
- Maintain personal training status/ accomplishments on "Flight Status" board.

PROGRAM EXPECTATIONS

- Schedule student into ground school class.

- Provide a properly maintained aircraft for flight training.

- Provide instruction on basic aircraft maintenance.
- Provide all supplies necessary for maintenance.
- Plan and conduct fund raising activities as necessary to fund the program.
- Provide quarterly information/safety meetings for students.
